LAST INFORMATION



COVID -19 MEASURES:

The Covid 19 measures are done according to the ICF protocol: https://www.canoeicf.com/sites/default/files/covid_protocol_icf_april_2022_v1.5.pdf. Negative Covid 19 test (rapid antigen/PCR performed in the last 48h) required prior the access to a competition venue from all participants (all National Team Members, Officials, ICF staff, OC), participants with positive Covid 19 test are not allowed to enter a competition venue.

All accredited individuals must wear a face mask indoors except when eating, drinking or exercising.

All occupants of the transport, including the driver, must wear face masks.

There is an obligation for all teams, officials and staff to stay at home/at the hotel if they show any symptoms of the Covid 19 disease like a fever (over 37.5 °C) or other symptoms of flu and immediately contact OC COVID-19 manager.

Management of a sick individual where Covid 19 is suspected will be according to ICF Covid Protocol (here).

1. Accreditation Office / Regatta Cash Desk

The Accreditation Centre will be located at the Administration Building and will start operating from Sunday, May 15 until Sunday May 22, 2022.

General:

- All participants of the Event must be accredited by ICF on-line system and no access to the Course without accreditation card will be allowed.
- Accreditation cards and body numbers will be issued to Team Leader only after payment of all remaining duties (accommodation and participation fee, meals, airport transfer).
- Team Leader has to present the National Federation Consent Form before collecting all accreditation cards.
- Only Team Leader will be allowed to enter the Accreditation Centre.

2. Accreditation cards

All participants need accreditation cards for the areas of the regatta course with restricted access. The passes have different numbers which designate the special allowance.

3. MEETINGs & CREW CHANGE

Within the Team Leaders meeting, technical information will be provided only. **Late Entry (click here)** and/or **Crew Change (click here)** forms can be submitted:

The deadline (for both types of submission) is **Wednesday, May 18, 18:00.** The forms must be signed by the team manager.

In exceptional, justified cases the crew change can be made at least one hour before the start of the day session. It must be submitted to the Chief Judge on the official Crew Change form in electronic version. Incompletely filled crew change forms may be rejected

4. TEST STARTS

The test starts will be provided on Thursday, May 19:

- on 1000 m start line 10:00 11:00 and
- on 500 m start line 15:00-16:00

5. BOAT NUMBERS and BODY NUMBERS

Body numbers are obligatory. The competitor/crew without the body number of each athlete may be disqualified.

The boat numbers are free of charge and can be collected before race at the designated place. All rented numbers must be returned after the race directly. Non-returned boat numbers will be charged to the national federation.

6. TRAINING AREA WITHIN THE RACES

The return channel and the area over the 1000m start line can be used for heating and training only. To approach the start line, please, use the return channel only. To use the competition channel part is strictly forbidden.

7. PRE-RACE BOAT CONTROL

The pre-race control is self boat control and it is the responsibility of competitors/team leaders. The pre-race boat scale will be available in the Athlete's area every day at 9:00-17:00 from Sunday, May 15 till Sunday, May 25.

8. UNIFORM AND UNIFORMITY

In a crew boat there must be uniformity among all athletes including sleeve length, hats, headbands. If used, spray covers must be the same. Using the spray cover for the first competitor in the crew boat is optional. Glasses are optional.

9. VICTORY CEREMONY

Victory ceremony will be held directly after each Final A race according to the final timetable under the finish tower. The awarded athlete will take the medal directly from the tray to carry it around their neck. The uniforms are obligatory. The team leaders may bring the uniforms to the 2nd boat control building before the ceremony for changing. All athletes whose are not just in time will be excluded

10. BICYCLES AND DRONES

Bicycles are allowed only on the island during the race.

All unbraked vehicles and drones without permission of Organizing committee are strictly forbidden during the race.

Rent of bicycles will not be provided.

11. Team Info

12. Storage of boats

When your boat transport arrives in Racice please put the them on boat racks at Athletes' Area. After having unloaded the trailers you have to park them without any dalay on designated parking.

13. Changing rooms and shower rooms

Participants not staying at Racice venue will have the changing rooms.

20. First aid, water rescue and MEDICAL CENTRE


